The Rusty 7-Day Reading + Math Challenge is a free supplemental resource for families with children ages 5-8. The web version requires no account.



A SIMPLE SEVEN-DAY HANDOFF

1. Give the parent flyer or complete packet directly to the adult.
2. Explain that online progress stays only in that browser.
3. Encourage five to seven calm minutes, then stop.
4. Invite the parent to choose one skill to revisit after Day 7.

GOOD FIT

Between-session practice, library activity tables, homeschool resource lists, after-school take-home packets, and parent workshops.

DO NOT PRESENT IT AS

A diagnostic test, grade-level measure, guaranteed learning result, substitute for teaching, or child account collection form.
